
Q1 What do you enjoy most about being part of Geraldton Amateur Swimming Club?








Q5 What is the swimmer's main reason for being a member of GASC?


Q6 How many time trials would you be willing to attend (with a member of your family to assist in voluntary roles)?




Q8 Would you and your family like to attend club social function dinners?


Q9 What would you consider a fair ratio with regards to cost of term fees and club deliverables?
