Our club's goal is to develop all four competitive swimming strokes safely and focus on short term and long-term development. Throughout your swim journey GASC aims to improve your water confidence, fitness, encourage healthy competition whilst providing a family friendly social environment.

To get started you need to have completed the VAC Stage 5, a squad assessment, a desire to improve your swimming skills and being part of a team. We hold time trials to help you monitor your progress throughout the term, semester or year.

Meets targeted:

- *Moora Open* Meet aimed at Regional Clubs, 5th of February 2024
- *Country Pennants* Held in a different WA location each year (Kalgoorlie 2024)
- *Country Championships* Regional Clubs can only register for this event. This meet is held at HBF Challenge Stadium Perth, annually (1st weekend in January)
- *Geraldton Short Course Classic* All WA Clubs are welcome to register. Our event is held annually (June long-weekend)

You can travel anywhere in the State to compete if you are interested, but it is not compulsory. You may wish to swim with GASC for your own personal goals and fitness levels but we do however encourage our members to participate in our club days to help you monitor your progress.

How To Register With GASC

New Swimmers need to be registered with both GASC and Swimming WA.

To register with GASC, new and returning swimmers will be sent a GASC registration form link. Please fill in the required information and click submit when completed.

To register for Swimming WA membership, visit <u>Swim Central</u> and select Geraldton Amateur Swimming Club in the 'find a club' list. Fill out your new member details.
